



Catholic Identity

Academics & Technology

Strategic Goal 1 (Technology): Alleman Catholic High School will provide access to and instruction in the ethical and appropriate use of up-to-date technological tools (e.g., digital lab instruments, 3-D printing, robotics, digital simulations).

- Develop digital/technological literacy skills in accordance with the Catholic worldview

Strategic Goal 2 (Curriculum): Alleman Catholic High School will provide diverse, flexible learning and growth opportunities, guiding all students to identify and nurture their God-given talents

- Provide increased access to and support for work and service-based learning opportunities
- Expand collaborations with community resources to increase the depth and breadth of advanced, developmental, and elective course offerings



Strategic Goal 3 (Staffing): Alleman Catholic High School will develop and implement a process to attract, develop, and retain highly competent mission and vision-driven employees.

- Support the temporal and financial demands for licensure and continuous professional development of faculty and staff
- Recruit experienced employees from non-educational backgrounds and support a route to certification and professional development
- Build a compensation infrastructure that rewards employees for performance excellence and institutional longevity





Advancement

Strategic Goal: Alleman Catholic High School will engage in and develop long lasting relationships to create a positive image, dynamic diverse programs, and long-term financial support to allow our mission to flourish.

- Develop a sustainable succession plan to ensure a passionate and personally invested Advancement team to further the mission of Alleman Catholic High School.
- Increase visibility and demonstrate the intrinsic value of Alleman Catholic High School by developing relationships with the Alleman community, parishes, and surrounding communities.
- Enhance the quality of our athletic programs by hiring and retaining coaches committed to our mission and the integration of our programs with partner schools.
- Create a plan to consistently ensure an active and vibrant presence of students in the life and service of our Catholic parishes and greater community.
- Implement a proactive and positive communication plan to build trust, restore confidence, and engage stakeholders.



Finance

Strategic Goal: Alleman Catholic High School will identify, communicate, and achieve clear financial objectives and procedures to responsibly, creatively, and enduringly provide the financial resources needed to support the mission of the school.

- Adjust operations to align expenses and revenue with enrollment levels.
- Analyze and structure tuition and financial assistance programs to optimize revenue.
- Invest in faculty and staff through development and compensation at a competitive level to encourage professional growth and retention of employees.
- Document and communicate financial conditions, plans, budgets, and results to constituents.
- Identify members of the community that can assist the school with financial administration.

Enrollment & Marketing

Strategic Goal: To achieve optimal enrollment, Alleman Catholic High School will provide a community in which families aspire to belong.

- Create an enrollment management and marketing plan to increase enrollment
- Expand potential enrollment efforts to Catholic home-school families, non-Catholic families, and families beyond the Quad-Cities Metro through marketing and sharing positive narratives
- Initiate proactive public relations that build trust and confidence in the community
- Reestablish core-Catholic community engagement to spread a sense of belonging
- Strengthen relationships with partner schools through effective communication and engagement







Facilities & Technology Infrastructure

Strategic Goal: Alleman Catholic High School's facilities and technology will reflect a standard and culture of excellence to attract and develop a diverse faculty, staff, and student body to enrich our faith-lived community.

- Execute a current facilities and technologies audit and generate a list of current and future needs that will translate into a rolling 3-5 year Capital Improvement Plan.
- Develop and implement a facilities and technologies standard and define the procedures, resources, and funding to support that standard.
- Establish a facilities technologies and operating committee that can provide oversight, transparency, and accountability.
- Institute a recurring process of connecting with other school board committees to review and update any facility and technology needs.



Governance

Strategic Goal: In partnership with the Diocese, Alleman Catholic High School will develop a governing structure that embraces and ensures excellence, collaboration, community, and accountability.

- Develop a collaborative governance model that fosters a sense of accountability, ownership, leadership, and communication with the operation of the school community to support the school's mission.
- Ensure the moral principle of a subsidiary and collaborative model of leadership with the goal of continuous improvement.
- Dialogue with the Diocese of Peoria to clarify lines of authority in managing the Illinois Quad City Catholic Schools with the understanding that decision-making must be a shared proposition.
- Define the relationship with local parishes to increase engagement in the life of the high school.
- Include local leaders from diverse backgrounds in governance to promote Alleman's profile.
- Align the leadership, communities and missions of Alleman, Jordan Catholic School, Seton Catholic School, and Our Lady of Grace Catholic Academy so that all schools can cohesively move in the same direction.













Student Life

Strategic Goal: To prepare students for successful post-secondary experiences, Alleman Catholic High School will develop a system to administer and moderate extracurriculars to create a balanced set of activities, furthering opportunities for fellowship, discipleship, and leadership.

- Provide STEM programs that allow students to develop their talents in these areas.
- Rejuvenate extracurriculars to attract and retain quality coaches and advisors who personify the same standards and expectations as those of Alleman faculty and staff.
- Develop programs with our partner schools that provide opportunities to participate in activities that nurture students' connection and commitment to our Catholic school community.
- Create awareness and excitement for students to feel needed, connected, and included in extracurricular activities and service opportunities.
- Increase awareness of opportunities and programs available to students in preparation for their postsecondary goals.
